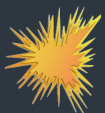
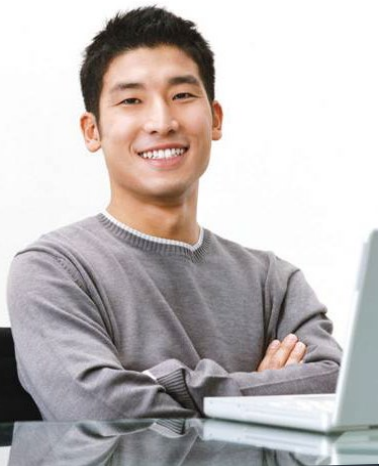
The baseline that we have can also be referred to as the contract we have agreed to. Catalyst will walk you through creation of a baseline and what to do once we have
